

Hobbie North, Miami



Hobbie North has been transformed into a welcoming waterfront park that reconnects the community with Biscayne Bay. The once underused shoreline now offers public access to the water, open green space, and recreational features, all designed with environmental protection and long-term resilience in mind.

The project balances natural beauty with public use—creating a safe, scenic space for walking, biking, swimming, kayaking, and more. Shaded paths, beach access, and panoramic views of the Miami skyline now define this revitalized stretch of bayfront.



- **Recreation & Access:**

- Beach area for swimming, snorkeling, and kayaking.
- Pedestrian and bike paths, open lawn space, and sand court for sports.
- Catch-and-release fishing zones and a scenic lookout point.
- Outdoor seating with skyline views, 44 public parking spaces (2 ADA), and 8 bike stations.

- **Environmental Features:**

- Native coastal planting and removal of invasive vegetation.
- Stormwater treatment and shoreline stabilization to protect Biscayne Bay.
- Upgraded outfalls and pollution control for improved water quality.

- **Infrastructure Improvements:**

- Erosion control, roadway protection, and sea level rise resiliency measures.

Hobbie North is now a vibrant, accessible, and sustainable park—offering a renewed connection to nature in the heart of Miami.
